


Regulatory Background

- ▶ District Rule 316.C.3 requires use of an ARB Certified Phase II vapor recovery system
- ▶ ARB Order CP-201 Defines the Certification Procedures for vapor recovery systems
 - Existing Phase II systems expire on 3/31/09
 - New EVR systems are all that remain 4/1/09
- ▶ ARB Does not Recognize Variances to State Requirements (e.g., CP-201)
- ▶ Stipulated Abatement Order process allowed for under [§42451](#)(b) of the [H&SC](#)

Phase II EVR Equipment



District Actions

- ▶ Direct Mailing to each Owner & Operator
 - ▶ ARB Public Meeting in Santa Barbara
 - ▶ Field Inspector Phone Survey and Site Visit Reminders
 - ▶ County Agency Coordination Meeting
 - ▶ Permit Staff Phone Calls and Follow-Up


Status Update

- ▶ 123 Stations Total (w/USTs)
 - 111 stations subject to April 1st deadline
 - 6 stations are exempt from Phase II (fleet/marine)
 - 3 stations Verizon/Cuyama will shut down
 - 3 stations have delayed compliance (BP/VP)
- ▶ 43 Stations In Compliance (PTO or SCDP)
- ▶ 3 Stations Are Temporarily Closed
- ▶ 15 Stations Have Requested the SOA (65/10/5)
- ▶ 50 Stations State they will Comply by April 1st
- ▶ All Required ATC Permits are Issued

District Approach

- ▶ Follow Guidance from ARB and CAPCOA
- ▶ Stipulated Order of Abatement ([here](#))
- ▶ Must Have an ATC Permit to Qualify
 - 100% of the stations that are not expected to be in compliance on April 1st meet the requirement
- ▶ [Attachment 1](#) and [Attachment 2](#) Completed by the Station Owner
 - Funding secured
 - Contractor secured

District Approach (Cont'd)

- Phase II EVR equipment ordered
 - Waiting on another agency's permit
 - Date set for construction
 - Date they expect to be in compliance
 - ▶ District will document the violation, but will use enforcement discretion
 - ▶ Stations w/out Stip'd Order of Abatement will be subject to being Tagged out of Service

District Approach (Cont'd)

- ▶ March 18th Hearing in Santa Maria (9:00 am)
 - 10 Stations (North County Stations)
- ▶ March 25th Hearing in Santa Barbara (9:00 am)
 - 5 Stations (South County Stations)
- ▶ April 1st Regular Meeting for Continuances
- ▶ Backup Provision for Late-Late Stations ?
 - Hear cases at April 1st Hearing Date (9:30 am)
 - Must obtain ATC permit by March 18th in order to make the 10-day newspaper notice
 - Santa Maria or Santa Barbara

- ▶ 3/5: Public Notice to Newspaper for 3/18 Hearing in SM
- ▶ 3/9: Docket Date for the 3/18 Hearing in SM
- ▶ 3/12: Public Notice to Newspaper for 3/25 Hearing in SB
- ▶ 3/16: Docket Date for the 3/25 Hearing in SB
- ▶ 3/18: Special Hearing Board Meeting in Santa Maria
- ▶ 3/18: [Pub Notice and Docket Date for 4/1 Hearing \(if req'd\)](#)
- ▶ 3/25: Special Hearing Board Meeting in Santa Barbara
- ▶ 4/1: Regular Hearing Board Meeting in Santa Maria
