Topic:	<u>Exemption of Air Pollutant Emitting Equipment at Wholesale Nurseries</u>

Boilers and other air pollutant emitting equipment used for heating purposes at wholesale nurseries in Santa Barbara County have been determined to meet the agricultural exemption in Health and Safety Code Section 42310(e) and, therefore, exempt from the permitting requirements of this District. As of September, 1990 all wholesale nurseries in the county have been notified of this exemption. This memo provides further guidance.

The Agricultural Commissioner operates a nursery inspection program and maintains a list of wholesale and retail nursery operations in the county. Attached is a letter which requests a determination as to a facility's wholesale or retail status. The latter facilities (i.e. retailers) are still subject to our APCD permit requirements and should be handled in the routine manner.

Please note that all operations (wholesale or retail) must comply with Prohibitory rules.

This policy takes effect immediately.

These policies and procedures shall not be interpreted in conflict with District Rules and Regulations or administrative policies, and may be modified or updated periodically without advance notice.
