PURPOSE

This policy provides a list of acceptable American Society for Testing and Materials (ASTM) methods for measuring the HHV in diesel, gasoline, JP-4 and JP-8 fuels.

GUIDANCE

A few ASTM methods can be used to determine HHV for different fuel types. The District reviewed appropriate ASTM procedures for HHV in the above fuels. Effective immediately, the test methods below are the only methods acceptable to the District for HHV measurements of the fuels indicated:

<u>ASTM Method No.</u>	<u>Fuel Type</u>
240	diesel, automotive gasoline, JP-4, JP-8
2382	JP-4, JP-8
3338	JP-4, JP-8

This policy will be reviewed periodically.
